On the night of January 21st, 1986, Detective Anthony J. Venditti, assigned to Organized Crime Control Bureau, was conducting an investigation into the activities of known organized crime members in the area of Myrtle Avenue in Ridgewood Queens.

During the investigation, Detective Venditti was confronted, in a sudden encounter, with the three organized crime members that he was surveilling. Without warning they opened fire. Detective Venditti was shot multiple times and mortally wounded.
